The Copley Society of Art is proud to present artist member Peter Knapp's work in our reimagined gallery space, The Little Gallery. *Yesterday • Today • Tomorrow* presents a 50-year narrative arc tracing the evolution of Peter Knapp's mark-making from 1976 to the present day. The show is structured as a temporal journey, moving through the woodcut lineage of his past, the urgent inquiries of his present, and the uncharted horizons of his future.

From a young age, Knapp gained a fascination with structural integrity and the physical "grit" of making which continues to define his practice today. The exhibition combines his early artistic talent with his most recent inquiries, exemplified in *Beyond*: a singular, just-completed work that melds his history with the future vision he carries in his soul, a testament to a lifetime dedicated to creative discovery. Through this exhibition, Knapp demonstrates that an artist's history is not a static timeline, but a living source for innovation. In his own words, "art is more than a vocation; it is a path of discovery that moves beyond the personal to explore universal themes of resilience, nature, and our place within the universe."
